
### Grade II Listed Public Library

**Bethnal Green Library is part of the Bethnal Green Gardens Conservation Area and is of special architectural and historic interest.**

Situated in Tower Hamlets London, this Grade II Listed Public Library was originally constructed in 1896 as the wing of an asylum. The building is two-storey brick constructed with a Neo-Georgian interior.

The Library opened its doors in 1922 and in 2015, the library was upgraded internally as part of Tower Hamlets Council's programme of investment in the area. A further internal and long planned external refurbishment commenced in the spring of 2018 and was completed by the summer.





**Working closely with the London Borough of Tower Hamlets, The Breyer Group's roofing division selected SIGA's most popular slate, SIGA 39 at 500 x 250mm as the closest match for existing materials predominant in the area.**

Sourced from the San Vicente Region, Spain, **its aesthetically pleasing blue grey textured finish, combined with its W1 (< 0,6%) T1, S1 rating, makes SIGA 39 the obvious choice for both new build and refurbishment projects, giving a long-lasting beautiful roof finish.**

The project has since been nominated for a London Planning Award.
